Tree Planting Instructions

Thank you for purchasing a tree from Windmill Heights Garden Center! Trees add value and beauty to our world, and we're excited for you to enjoy this tree for many years to come. Planting a tree is fun and rewarding. Just follow these instructions, and then flip to the back page for a watering guide and checklist. Just check off the steps as you go!

Choose a location. Keep in mind the final size of the tree - don't plant under power lines or too near the house!
Water the tree thoroughly before planting.
Dig hole as deep as the root-ball and twice as wide.
If your soil is poor and you want to amend it soil, use compost or topsoil blend. Usually 1 or 2 bags is sufficient. We do not recommend "potting soil" or peat moss for this purpose.
Plant the tree so that the top of the root-ball is 1 inch higher than the surrounding natural soil.
Crumble the soil and fill in the hole. Gently press down to push out the air gaps.
Mulch the tree with at least 3 bags of soil, at a depth of 2 inches minimum, extending out at least 2 feet away from the trunk. Mulch helps kill weeds and keeps the soil from drying out.
Stake the tree ONLY if the tree is in danger of being blown over. Remove staking after 2 months.
In areas with deer or rabbits, a wire or plastic guard may be needed to prevent them from damaging the stem. Make sure there is sufficient room for the trunk to grow and expand. Check twice a year, and remove when the tree bark has gained strength (usually when the trunk is 4 inches in diameter)
Water immediately with at least 5 gallons of water. Fertilizer is not necessary; we generally like to wait until the second year to fertilize.
